SCi to publish *Constantine* videogame

Console game developed by Bits Corp and Licensed by Warner Bros. Interactive Entertainment

Bits Corp plc ('Bits' or 'Bits Corp'), a leading UK developer of video game software for major console platforms, today reports that it has secured a publishing and distribution agreement with SCi Games Ltd for its license to *Constantine*. As recently announced, Warner Bros. Interactive Entertainment have granted Bits Corp the license to develop a video game for the upcoming Warner Bros. Pictures film of the same name, based upon Alan Moore's celebrated DC Comics/Vertigo™ comic book character.

Based on the DC Comics/Vertigo *Hellblazer* graphic novels, the supernatural thriller *Constantine* tells the story of John Constantine (Keanu Reeves), a man who has literally been to hell and back. When he teams up with sceptical policewoman Angela Dodson (Rachel Weisz) to solve the mysterious suicide of her twin sister, their investigation takes them through the world of demons and angels that exists just beneath the landscape of contemporary Los Angeles. Caught in a catastrophic series of otherworldly events, the two become inextricably involved and seek to find their own peace at whatever cost.

Commenting on the agreement, Foo Katan, CEO of Bits Studios, said; "After securing the license and working closely with Warner Bros. Interactive Entertainment on our game adaptation of the film, we are delighted to have SCi Games as our publishing partner on such an exciting project."

Jane Cavanagh, CEO of SCi Games said; "We are very pleased to be able to announce this agreement with Warner Bros. Interactive Entertainment and Bits for this motion picture license. The progress of the game is extremely encouraging."

“Constantine is an extremely promising property, and we are excited to work with SCi and Bits on developing dynamic action-based videogames based on the film,” said Jason Hall, Senior Vice President of Warner Bros. Interactive Entertainment.

Constantine the game is already well into development and will be released on Sony PlayStation®2 and Microsoft Xbox™ to coincide with the film release in 2005.
